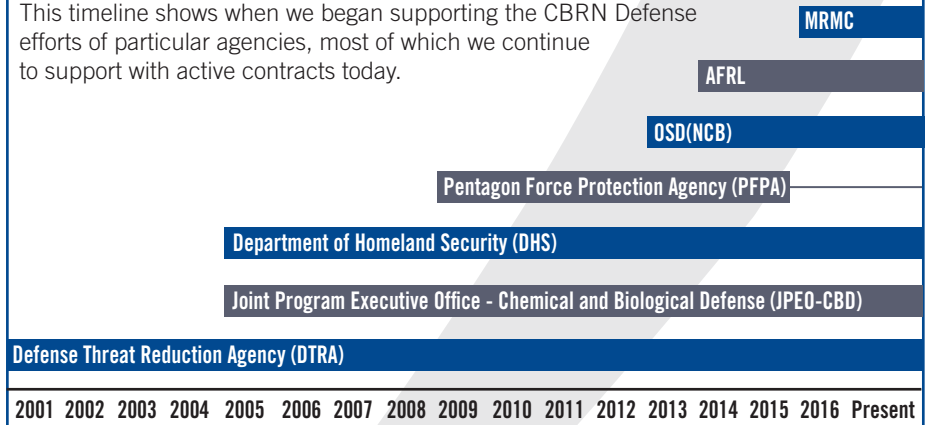

Our Achievements

We apply subject matter expertise, technical and operational experience, and analytic rigor to address the CBRN Defense concerns of the Warfighter and the Homeland

- Our Bioengineer and Medical Advisor support to JPEO-CBD spans every medical countermeasure solution area, including vaccines, biological therapeutics, chemical countermeasures, and diagnostics systems.
- We provide DTRA's R&D Directorate with scientific, regulatory and program support staff in Chemical & Biological defense, and we completed an AoA for a critical Arms Control information system.
- We provided key subject matter expertise to the Pentagon review of the 2015 Anthrax sample mishaps. We were instrumental in developing novel approaches to eliminate the need for pathogenic strains of biological agents while satisfying the diverse needs of a broad testing community (DoD and Non-DoD).
- We oversaw a complete medical portfolio review assessment for the CBD medical enterprise. This laid the foundation for key initiatives to improve the development and delivery of medical countermeasures, for which we assist in implementation.
- On a prime contract with the Joint Project Manager Transformational Medical Technologies (JPM-TMT) program, we provided medical and regulatory SMEs to support the acquisition of medical countermeasures. We successfully defended this work through program transition, as a prime for the Joint Product Manager Biodefense Therapeutics (JPdM BDTX) program and on 28 task orders under the JPEO-CBD OPETS vehicle.
- For OSD(NCB), we completed the CDBP Enterprise Risk Assessment Framework for planning capital investment in infrastructure, materiel, and sustainment. We also led the effort to develop and publish the CDBP Program Strategy Guidance and implementation plan.
- We led interagency cooperative efforts with OSD, DHS, HHS, and Joint Science and Technology Office (JSTO), which led to substantive collaboration on 12 projects, including assay development, sensor technology, and modeling, along with a framework for an evolutionary bio-alliance between the key organizations.
- As the prime SETA support contractor for the DHS OHA BioWatch program, we analyzed requirements for a new biosurveillance system, and we developed the system's Operational Requirements Document (ORD), which was noted by the DHS Undersecretary of Management as the model for future ORDs.
- We have conducted six formal Analyses of Alternatives (AoAs) for the Chemical and Biological Defense Program (CBDP). During the results briefing for the Common Analytic Laboratory System (CALs) AoA, the Deputy JPEO-CBD stated that our methodology was the most clearly articulated and comprehensive he had ever seen, and that he expected future AoAs to follow a similar methodology and ensure the same level of analytic rigor.
- We have organized eight National BioWatch Workshops for DHS OHA, coordinating hundreds of stakeholders from around the country for a three-day conference on biosurveillance.
